



IMPORTANT INFORMATION!

Upcoming Event in Your Neighborhood

Dear Resident,

This letter is to inform you that the 43rd annual Steamboat Marathon will be held on Sunday, June 2, 2024. Your home is along our race route and we would like to provide you with the following information to make the day as seamless and stress-free as possible.

Road Closure:

- The westbound lanes of Lincoln Avenue will be closed from 5th to 11th streets for the finish line from 6:00 am – 3:00 pm on Sunday, June 4th.
- Both lanes of traffic will be on the eastbound lanes of Lincoln Avenue during the road closure.
- Traffic control will be in place on Routt County Road 129.
- Northbound traffic on 129 will be diverted to the left lane just past the entrance to Elk River Estates and will proceed north to Cullen's corner.
- Southbound traffic on 129 will be diverted at Cullen's Corner onto Routt County Road 44 and then back onto 129 just north of the Bob Adam's Airport.
- From Cullen's Corner north to the start of the Half Marathon near Moon Hill will be one way traffic, controlled by a pilot car leading traffic on the west side of the road.

- Set up - Sunday, June 2 - 5:00am - 7:30am
- Event 7:30am - 1pm
- Breakdown 1pm - 3pm

RACE INFORMATION

We are excited to reach out to you with news about the 43rd annual Steamboat Marathon in your neighborhood this June! The Steamboat Marathon is one of the kickoff events to summer and ranked as one of the "Top 10 Destination Marathons in North America." The races will bring athletes and spectators to our beautiful mountain town for a weekend away while also bringing our community together for a fun morning of high-fives, laughter and a good time.

Please expect delays and closures on CR129, Highway 40/Lincoln, and Oak Street on June 4. Parking will be limited on Oak Street, Lincoln Avenue and cross streets. There will be a full road closure on 6th Street from Lincoln to Yampa until 1:00 p.m.

As in past years, Community Service Officers will be assisting during each event with traffic detours and any other traffic/emergency needs.



Please find enclosed in this letter a map of the aid stations and portable toilets on the course. Portable toilets will be dropped at their locations on May 31 and picked up on Monday, June 3. Aid stations will be set up early on June 2 and broken down by noon.

We asked that during this time you are aware of the volunteers working these aid stations and of the runners on the road. I have provided my contact information below if you would like to connect about the details outlined in this letter.
