The Moots Ranch Rally is now in it's 10th year. This event serves as a bridge between road users and rancher in the area. It is a fundraiser for the CAA (Community Ag Aliance).

The event is a non-competitive bike ride using county road ways which are primarily made up of dirt and gravel surfaces, as shown in the attached map and cue sheets. Two distances will be offered to participants:

- "The "FULL BULL" 71.9 miles
- "The WRANGLER" 51.6 miles

We anticipate approximately 250 cyclists riding in this "rules of the road" event. The event will not use any highways, nor will we require any road closures. We do not expect to cause any interruptions to the normal flow of traffic.

The event is working with the Community Agriculture Alliance (CAA). The CAA has given their full backing of the event, which will showcase the historic ranches on the route. The event will also raise money for the CAA as a donation to keep these ranches part of our community and history.

### MOOTS RANCH RALLY JUNE 8TH, 2024

## TRAFFIC PLAN FOR RCR 129 TO CR 44 and RCR 56 TO RCR 54

The Ranch Rally has two sections of the route that use 1.4 and 2.5 miles for a total of 3.9 miles of RCR 129. Below is our plan to lesson the impact and ensure a safe event.

#### **SECTION 1**

RCR 129 to RCR 44 (1.4miles)


- The ride event starts promplty at 8:30am from the Moots parking lot at 2545 Copper Ridge Drive. We roll the entire group out at the same time to limit the impact on traffic. From there the route will proceed north on Copper Ridge Drive and intersect with RCR 129. At that point the route turns right.
  - (At this corner we will have a marshall signaling to turn right only after making a stop and making sure traffic is clear.)
- Once onto 129 riders will ride single files as much as possible until the left turn onto RCR44.
- At the intersection of 129 & RCR44 we will have two marshals with safety vests and hand held stop signs to monitor the flow of traffic and stop traffic as the group passes. This should have minimal impact/stoppage on traffic flow.

\*\*We will also have a sherif's patrol car leading the group to RCR 44, as well as a final sweep vehicle at the last rider position to clear the road. Total time to get the group to RCR 44 is 10 minutes or less.


#### **SECTION 2**

RCR 56 to RCR 54 on RCR 129 (2.5 miles)

- We will have a corner marshall at the corner of RCR 56 & 129 as riders turn right onto 129.
  The marshall will be instructing all riders to stay single file and as far right as possible. We will also have signs above the intersection of RCR 56 & RCR 129 that alerts drivers to the event and riders on the road.
- We will have another corner marshall at the inter section of RCR 54 & 129 as the riders turn right off of 129. Below the intersection of 129 we will have signage alerting vehicle traffic traveling north on 129 that there is an event in progress, be alert.


