The Moots Ranch Rally is now in it's 10th year. This event serves as a bridge between road users and rancher in the area. It is a fundraiser for the CAA (Community Ag Alliance).

## RULES OF THE ROAD

All participants must read and be aware of the following rules:

### OBEY TRAFFIC LAWS, SIGNS AND SIGNALS

Bicyclists have all rights and duties applicable to the driver of any other vehicle and can be penalized for violating traffic laws.

### RIDE SINGLE FILE

Ride two abreast only when you are not impeding traffic (front or rear) or when all cyclists are on the shoulder. On curving canyon roads, play it safe and ride single file.

## REQUIRED INFORMATION

1. A map or diagram of the route, showing all control points, aid stations or other items in the ROW and any detours. A map of parking location(s) and number of spaces proposed for participants
2. A certificate of insurance naming Routt County
3. A Method of Handling Traffic (MHT) must be included with this permit application. The MHT shall include:
  - x A description of all road/lane/major intersection closures.
  - x A map showing location of traffic signs, flaggers, and other traffic control.
  - x Time frame for the closures.
  - x # of personnel involved with controlling closures (flaggers/marshals)
  - x Primary contact during closures (this may be the Traffic Control Supervisor)
  - x If primary or paved roads are utilized, certified paid traffic control or police is required
4. If event has subcontracted traffic control, please submit with this application: name of company and contact of traffic control supervisor (TCS) for event including TCS's cell phone number.

TRAFFIC PLAN FOR RCR 129 TO CR 44 and RCR 56 TO RCR 54

The Ranch Rally has two sections of the route that use 1.4 and 2.5 miles for a total of 3.9 miles of RCR 129. Below is our plan to lessen the impact and ensure a safe event.

**SECTION 1**

RCR 129 to RCR 44 (1.4miles)

- The ride event starts promptly at 8:30am from the Moots parking lot at 2545 Copper Ridge Drive. We roll the entire group out at the same time to limit the impact on traffic. From there the route will proceed north on Copper Ridge Drive and intersect with RCR 129. At that point the route turns right.
  - (At this corner we will have a marshall signaling to turn right only after making a stop and making sure traffic is clear.)
- Once onto 129 riders will ride single files as much as possible until the left turn onto RCR44.
- At the intersection of 129 & RCR44 we will have two marshals with safety vests and hand held stop signs to monitor the flow of traffic and stop traffic as the group passes. This should have minimal impact/stoppage on traffic flow.

\*\*We will also have a sheriff's patrol car leading the group to RCR 44, as well as a final sweep vehicle at the last rider position to clear the road. Total time to get the group to RCR 44 is 10 minutes or less.

**SECTION 2**

RCR 56 to RCR 54 on RCR 129 (2.5 miles)

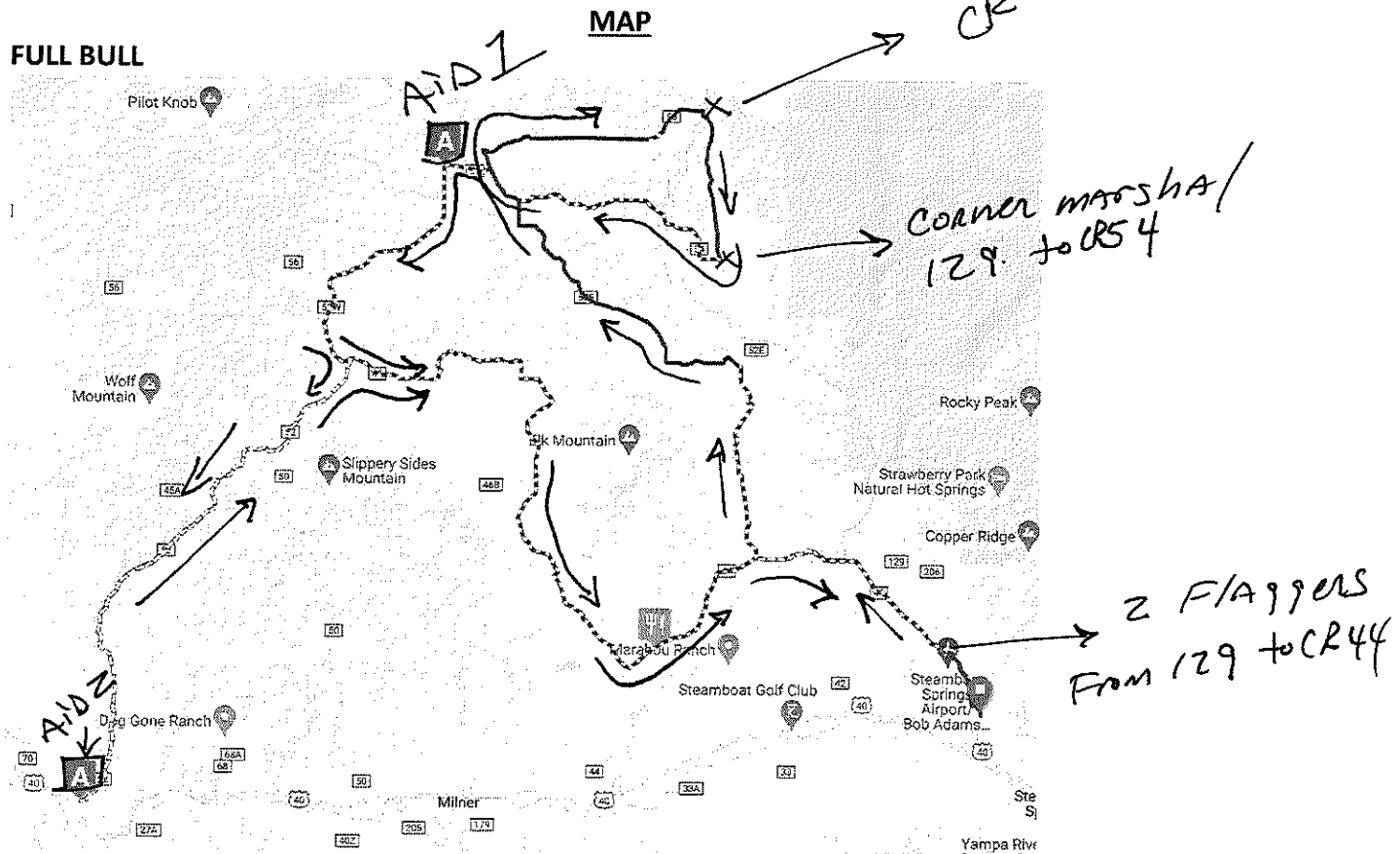
- We will have a corner marshall at the corner of RCR 56 & 129 as riders turn right onto 129. The marshall will be instructing all riders to stay single file and as far right as possible. We will also have signs above the intersection of RCR 56 & RCR 129 that alerts drivers to the event and riders on the road.
- We will have another corner marshall at the intersection of RCR 54 & 129 as the riders turn right off of 129. Below the intersection of 129 we will have signage alerting vehicle traffic traveling north on 129 that there is an event in progress, be alert.

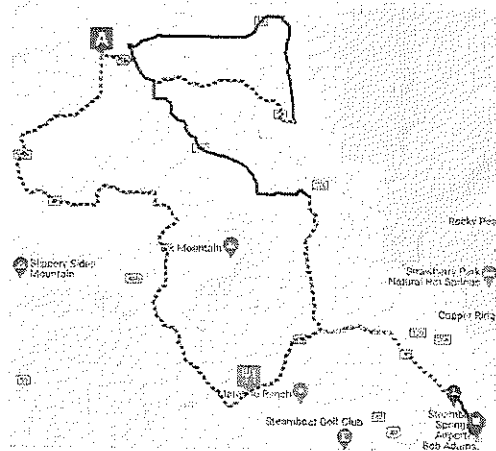

WRANGLER is similar without the out-and-back on RCR52



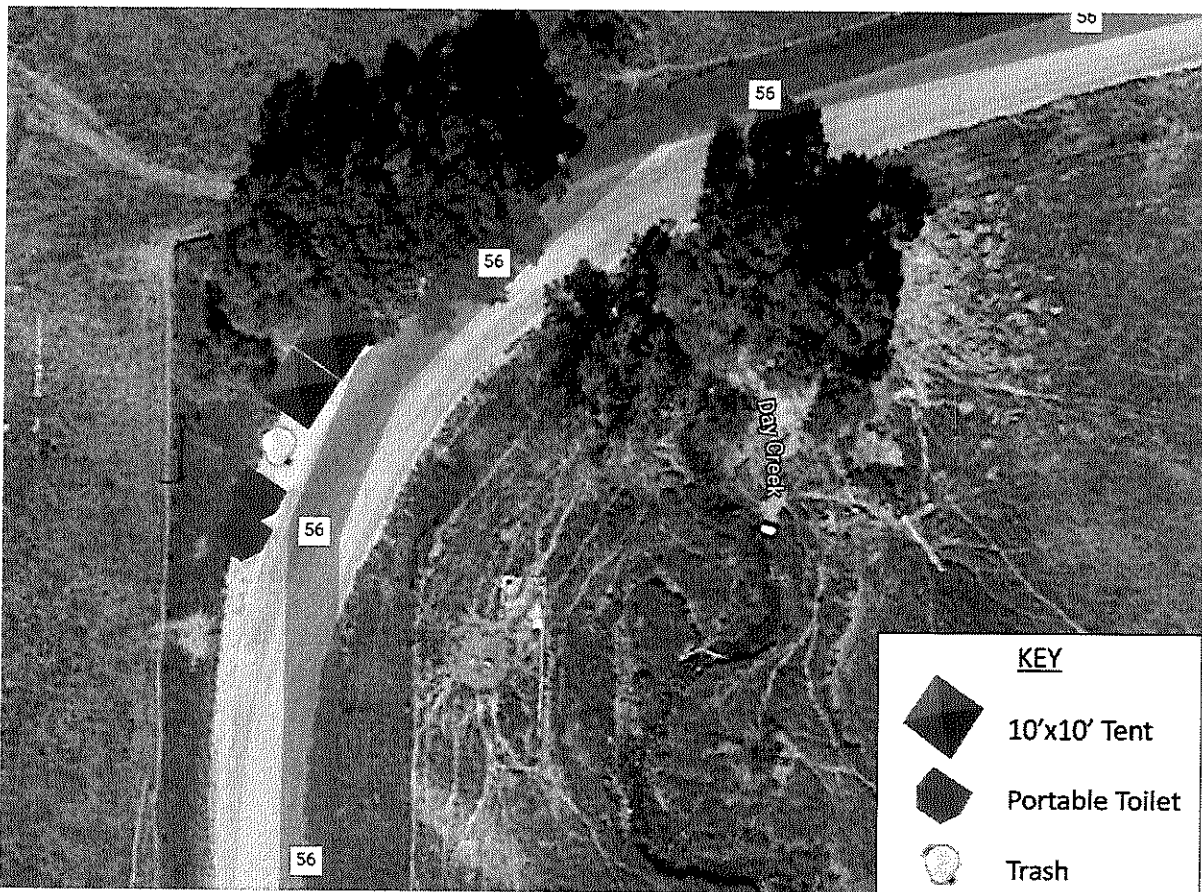

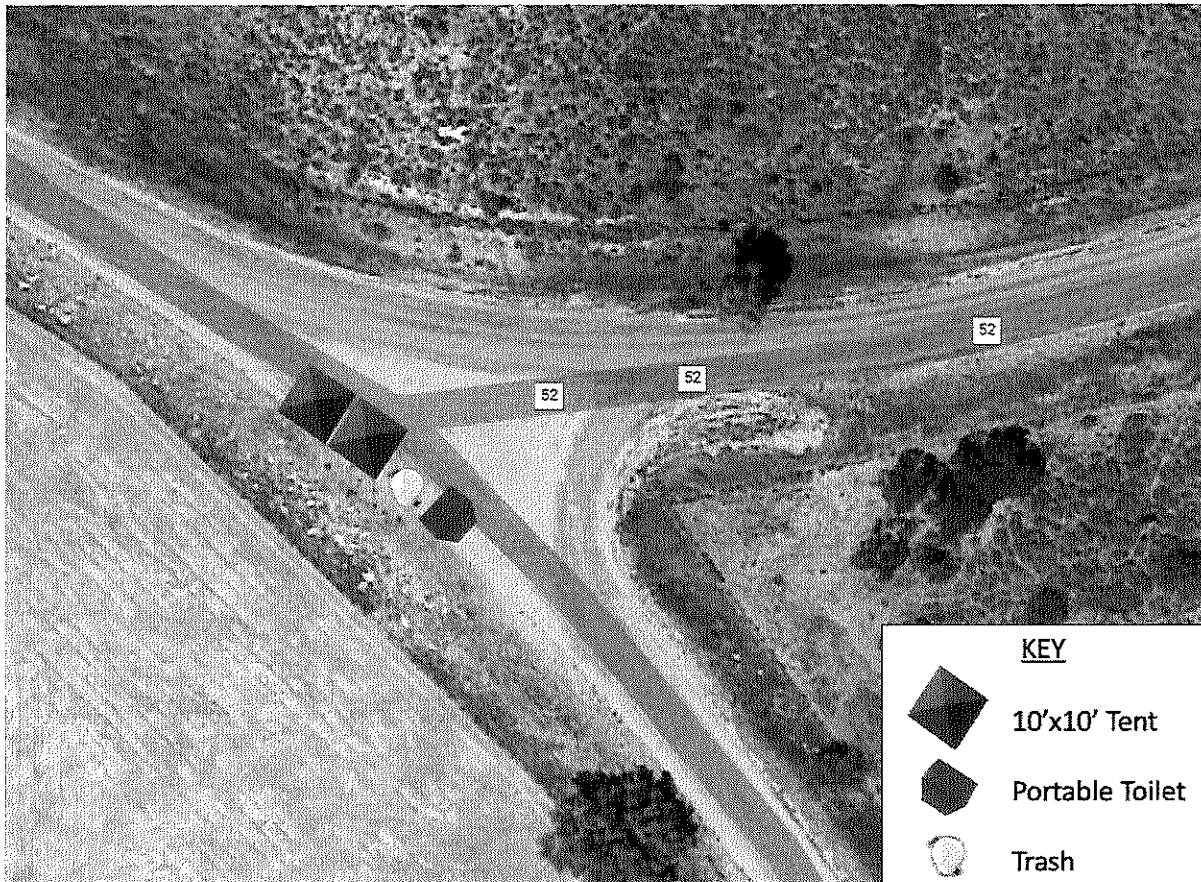
