



Built @ 1963

Building footprint is 40x160

Main beams are all the same size and spaced on 20 foot spacing. End walls have additional beams and z-purlins are used at walls and roof.

The east section of 40x60 is the former mine office areas and on two floors. The first floor included 3 locker rooms with showers and multiple toilets each. Also on first floor were work areas for processing coal samples. The second floor was broken out into small offices, conference and break rooms.

The middle section of the building was the warehouse area and included the mechanicals for the well, septic, heat. It has dividing walls on each end.

The west section of the building was for equipment maintenance and included an overhead crane, machining and welding equipment.
