Dear Applicant-

The Routt County Regional Building Department is providing you with a Notice that your Permit Application is due to expire on <u>01/23/2019</u>. All permit applications expire 180 days after they are submitted; unless the Building Department receives a notification in advance requesting the application period to be extended or the permit is issued.

R105.3.2 Time Limitation of Application. An application for a permit for any proposed work shall be deemed to have been abandoned 180 days after the date of filing unless such application has been pursued in good faith or a permit has been issued; except that the building official is authorized to grant one or more extension of time for additional periods not exceeding 180 days each. The extension shall be requested in writing and justifiable cause demonstrated.

<u>Section 105.1 Permits Required.</u> Any owner or authorized agent who intends to construct, enlarge, alter, repair, move, demolish, or change the occupancy of a building or structure, or to erect, install, enlarge, alter, remove, convert or replace any electrical, gas, mechanical or plumbing system, the installation which is regulated by this code, or to cause any such work to be done, shall first make application to the building official and obtain the required permit (s).

<u>Section 113.1 Unlawful acts</u>. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to erect, construct, alter, extend, repair, move, remove, demolish or occupy any building, structure or equipment regulated by this code, or cause same to be done, in conflict with or in violation of any of the provisions of this code.
