- Exposed nails are ring shank and galvanized for maximum strength and no rust spots or stains.
- The 2×4" reinforced doors are designed to seal out rain and include key locks for added security.
- Air vents are positioned to create optimal circulation and temperature control to protect your belongings.
- Pressure-treated decking to prevent rotting.
- Floor joists are created with pressure-treated boards and positioned 16" on center for 10' wide and larger buildings and set into notched 4" x 6" pressure-treated skids for maximum strength and durability, especially under heavy snow loads.
- Garage floor joists are positioned 12" on center to carry the extra weight of ATVs, large mowers, cars, etc.
- Wall studs are placed 16" on center.
- Painted and Urethane buildings are built with engineered wood panels.
- Metal roofs and asphault shingles are provided at the same price.
