

Warhorse Ranch Freedom Retreat Narrative Warhorse Ranch is hosting an intensive retreat which is specifically designed to support individuals dealing with trauma, particularly veterans, first responders, and their families. These retreats provide a safe and nurturing environment where participants will engage in various therapeutic activities, including equine therapy, mindfulness environmental exercises on the land, and peer support sessions. By working closely with horses, individuals learn to build trust, improve communication, and develop emotional resilience. The serene ranch setting allows for deep relaxation and reflection, promoting healing and personal growth. This retreat provides two of the 5 days to be offsite at local outfitters to engage in supportive therapeutic activities. Hours of operation will be from 8:00AM to 5:00PM each day during the dates of the retreat. This retreat is restricted to a 6 person attendance. These attendees are also housed off-site at a local lodging entity. The restroom facility for participants and volunteers is located in the house on the property. The anticipated number of volunteers will be 15. Access to the property will be the main driveway to the property. There is no anticipated traffic. A Warhorse Ranch insured vehicle will be utilized to transport participants to and from lodging. On Thursday September 26th, participants will leave directly from lodging to Hahns Peak Lake for a licensed guided fly fishing experience. At noon they will return to the ranch for a half day of a licensed and guided horseback ride. At noon they will be returning to the ranch for a beekeeping experience and honey harvesting experience.
