Good Morning Team.

The document shows for the most part accurate information. I have gone over their nutrient loading numbers and they seem pretty consistent with the USGS and MCWSD data. In the document, they also propose construction of infrastructure to mitigate runoff onto Little Morrison Creek which is topographically accurate. They also talk about water quality testing throughout construction. (I would encourage that their HOA has do testing at least 2 times per year on Little Morrison Creek). And if the levels increase from the baseline, a mitigation process has to be implemented. (samples to be collected and sent to a reputable lab prior to construction)

Our new wastewater treatment plan should be able to handle most of their wastewater demands over time. However the new EPA limits are scheduled to be implemented in 2027. At that point I don't believe we can meet the new discharge limits.

I am sure something else will come up. I will keep you posted.
