BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Board of County Commissioners approves the Special Use Permit with the following conditions:

- The ground in which the sewer lines are laid should be regraded to original contours and either gravelled, paved, or reseeded back to original conditions.
- 2. The pump station should be compatible with structures in the vicinity and completely fenced and locked to prevent intruders.
- 3. The proposed sewage treatment plant must be engineered to prevent effluents from being reached by floodwaters, as stipulated by the Water Control Division of the State Health Department.
- 4. Intermittent overflow streams and channels should be diked or bermed to prevent them from flooding into the treatment lagoons.
- 5. Crossing should be approved by the Railroad, and an utility crossing agreement for pipeline under the tracks should be approved prior to construction.
- 6. This Special Use Permit is for the life of the sewage treatment facilities. DONE this 13th day of April, 1982.
