The Hazardous Materials and Waste Management Division of the Department of Public Health and Environment (the Division) received on June 24, 2003 a document in response to a Compliance Advisory dated June 12, 2003 issued by the Division to Twin Landfill Corporation, Routt County, Colorado. A supplement to the response dated October 17, 2003 was received on October 22, 2003 provides as built drawings and photographs of the Leachate Seep Collection System that was recently installed.
