I am the owner of the property that was home to the recently-closed RK Pet Ranch. I bought the property and the business from the previous owners in November of 2021. We closed in May of 2023 due to ongoing staffing issues. I hope to repurpose the building for another community resource.

I have always loved animals and I have benefited from the therapeutic qualities of surrounding myself with them. In addition to household pets, I have been involved with horses from a young age and have a B.S. degree in equine science. I am also a trained Life Coach with a certification in Equine-Facilitated Coaching. I am passionate about helping people improve their lives and strongly believe that animals provide meaningful relationships and interactions to help people understand themselves and the world around them. I have also been an educator at the middle school and community college level.

I have a vision for the pet ranch building that combines my passions for mental health, education and animals. I would like to create a Community Wellness Center/Collective that allows myself and other practitioners the chance to incorporate animals into a variety of services. I envision partnering with professionals and organizations to bring enriching activities, therapies and educational opportunities to the public. I find it difficult to pin down an exact description of the proposed business as this is a unique idea that will surely evolve as it grows.
